The awards are presented “annually to firms that have demonstrated a commitment to raising the bar on funeral service excellence by adhering to strict ethical and professional standards and providing outstanding service to families and communities,” according to the NFDA.

In addition, the Oliverie Funeral Home and Waitt Funeral Home and Cremation Service were honored in the NFDA’s Best of the Best Award competition. To apply, funeral homes needed to submit an essay discussing a “program or service that had a positive impact on the families they serve or their community,” the NFDA said.

The Waitt Funeral Home was named one of three Best of the Best Award recipients, while the Oliverie Funeral Home received a Certificate of Honorable Mention for its efforts.
